Eberhard Ross (1959) is a recognized German artist, who has been painting and drawing for more than 30 years. He studied Fine Art at Hochschule Essen and at Kunstakademie Düsseldorf in Germany. His work is inspired by the philosophy of Zen Buddhism which is revealed in his art, both in the subject matter as in its execution. In his more abstract “Speicher” works, Ross painstakingly covers canvases, aluminium and sheets of drawing paper with calligraphic networks of lines and pattern that develop organically in a repetitive process. As he tries to interpret the natural lines and curves found in nature, he is also exploring how the tones and hues of colour are affected by the mark-making. Eberhard has been awarded more than once and his work can be found in several important museums and collections worldwide. He is performing solo and group exhibitions on an international level over more than 10 years now.
