

## Regulatory compliance of CLA-252

### 1. Hazard classification (CLP Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008)

CLA-252 is classified according to CLP based on the calculation method as Eye Irrit. 2, H319 due to the ingredients dodecylbenzenesulphonic acid, monoethanolamine salt (Skin Irrit. 2, H315 (<10%=>not classified for skin effects) and Eye Irrit. 2, H319) and fatty alcohol ethoxylate (< 5% Eye Dam. 1, H318) (Sections 2 and 3 of the MSDS).

### 2. Transport classification

CLA-252 is not classified as dangerous for transport according to ADR, RID, IMDG or IATA. It can therefore be transported by road, sea or air without any special precautions.

### 3. REACH (Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 and amendments)

As such, CLA-252 is a mixture and is therefore exempted from registration under REACH. The ingredients of CLA-252 are all registered under REACH and the uses of these substances have been verified by CHP N.V. as a downstream user. CLA-252 does not contain any substances falling under the limitations of REACH. Annex XVII, the REACH candidate list or REACH Annex XIV.

The MSDS of CLA-252 complies with Article 31 of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH) of 18 December 2006 (Requirements for safety data sheets) and Annex II of REACH, as amended by two Commission Regulations:

- Commission Regulation (EU) No 453/2010: alignment of the SDS with the applicable requirements arising from implementation of the changes in classification and labeling of substances and mixtures according to the CLP Regulation from 1 December 2010 and 1 June 2015 respectively. (of 20 May 2010)
- Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/830: adaptation to the 5th revision of the GHS and avoidance of confusion generated by two potentially conflicting amendments entering into force on the 1 June 2015. (of 28 May 2015)

### 4. Detergents regulation (Regulation (EC) No 648/2004)

CLA-252 fully complies with the Detergents Regulation and the surfactants used in this product are all biodegradable.

### 5. Biocidal Products Regulation (Regulation (EU) No 528/2012)

CLA-252 is out of scope of the BPR; it is only intended for cleaning purposes and does not contain any active substances identified under this Regulation.

### 6. Conclusion

In conclusion, CLA-252 complies with all regulations relevant for this product.



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
